Leisure Skating is provided for the enjoyment of all participants. Admittance is limited to participating skaters or skaters with parent/guardian accompaniment. All patrons who participate in the leisure skating program are to respect the following rules.

- For the safety of your children, adult accompaniment is strongly recommended.
- Sticks, pucks, balls, chairs or strollers are not permitted on the ice surface. Leisure Centre skate devices may only be used during parent and child skating, parent and tot skating and Wednesday afternoon public skating (check schedule for dates and times). Leisure skating devices must not be left unattended.
- Only persons wearing skates and/or usage of a wheelchair are permitted on the ice surface. (Parent's may assist children during the parent and tot skates at their own risk, and must be wearing skates).
- Food or drink is not permitted on the ice surface.
- Everyone must skate in the same direction. Backwards skating or playing tag is not permitted.
- When the buzzer sounds, all patrons are required to leave the ice surface immediately.
- The centre ice area is reserved for parents with small children who are learning to skate. All other skaters must stay clear of this area.
- Any general horseplay including play fighting or deliberate interference with other skaters will result in the patron being asked to leave the area immediately.
- Leisure Services Staff will be available on site to enforce these rules and ensure a safe skating environment for all patrons. The Leisure Services staff has the authority from the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to have any person(s) not abiding by these rules removed from the facility.
- Ice surface capacity – 180 participants at any one time.
- The skate change area is the designated location for patrons to change into their skates.
- **Full protective required for Adult Shinny and Adult Shinny Sledge Hockey drop in including helmet and hockey gloves.**
- **Helmets are highly recommended, especially for children.**
